Privacy policy for COVID-19 information

1. Person in charge

The data processing described below is carried out by WOMA GmbH, Werthausener Str. 77 - 79, 47226 Duisburg (hereinafter referred to as "we" or "us") as the party responsible within the meaning of the applicable data protection law. 2. Health data

Due to the current health hazards caused by the so-called corona virus COVID-19, the following data is collected for reasons of health care. The data is used to assess health risks due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus. Before entering one of our factory premises, you will be asked to complete a short questionnaire. In addition to your name and the name of the company you work for, this questionnaire asks whether you have been in one of the COVID-19 risk areas in the past 15 days, whether you have had contact with such persons and whether you have shown symptoms of body temperature above 37.5 °C or coughing in the past 15 days. This information is only collected if you have expressly consented to it in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a), 9 para. 2 lit. a) DSGVO.

The granting of consent is voluntary. Consent can be revoked at any time with effect for the future by e-mail to the contact address given below.

3. Passing on of the data

Your personal data will only be passed on if it is legally permissible or necessary. This may be the case, for example, if the processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of you or another natural person.

4. Storage and deletion of data

We will keep the questionnaire you have completed in a separate container separate from other documents. After 6 weeks after you have handed over the questionnaire to us, we will safely destroy your questionnaire.

5. Your rights as a data subject

You have the right to obtain from us, at any time and upon request, information on the personal data processed by us and relating to you in accordance with Article 15 of the DSGVO. To this end, you may submit a request by post or by e-mail to the address given below.

You have the right to ask us to correct the personal data concerning you without delay if it is incorrect. To do so, please contact us at the contact addresses given below.

You have the right to ask us to delete any personal data concerning you under the conditions described in article 17 DSGVO. These conditions provide in particular for a right of deletion if the personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed, as well as in cases of unlawful processing, opposition or the existence of an obligation to delete them under Union law or the law of the Member State to which we

are subject. For the period of data retention, see also point 4 of this privacy statement. To exercise your right of deletion, please contact us at the addresses below.

You have the right to demand that we restrict processing in accordance with Art. 18 DSGVO. This right exists in particular if the accuracy of the personal data is disputed between the user and us, for the period of time required to verify its accuracy, and in the event that the user requests limited processing instead of deletion in the case of an existing right to deletion; also in the event that the data is no longer required for the purposes pursued by us, but the user requires it for the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims, and if the successful exercise of an objection is still disputed between us and the user. To exercise your right to limit the processing, please contact us at the contact addresses below.

You have the right to obtain from us the personal data concerning you which you have provided us with in a structured, common, machine-readable format in accordance with Art. 20 DSGVO. To exercise your right to data transferability, please contact us at the contact addresses below.

You have the right to object at any time, for reasons arising from your particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning you, which is carried out on the basis of Art. 6, paragraph 1, letter f) DPA, in accordance with Art. 21 DPA. We will stop processing your personal data unless we can prove compelling reasons for processing that are worthy of protection and outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or if the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.

You also have the right to contact the responsible supervisory authority in the event of complaints. The responsible supervisory authority is the State Commissioner for Data Protection of North Rhine-Westphalia.
