WARNING! – DO NOT use the machine if it is not operating correctly or damaged. Report it immediately to your Manager on duty, then let your Line Manager know.



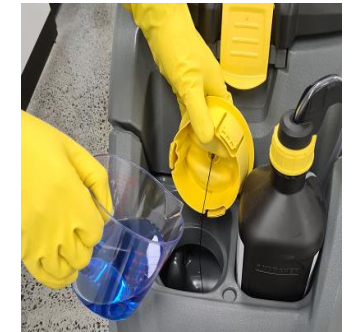
Step 1
Put on disposable gloves and erect safety sign in place



Step 2
Turn off the power, unplug the charger from the mains holding the plug. Wind the mains cable around the holders



Step 3
Connect the hose to the automatic filling system and open the water supply (max. 60c, max. 5 bars)



Step 4 (manual only)
Wearing safety goggles, pour the correct chemical into the fresh water tanks. Refer to Daily Floor Care chart for appropriate chemical



Step 4 (auto dose only)
Check auto dose bottle to ensure the correct chemical has been inserted and there is enough chemical to complete the task



Step 5
Attach pad to pad driver by inserting pad under the central locating point



Step 6
Attach pad driver to scrubber machine by pushing up into place



Step 7
Turn the program selection switch to "OFF"

Step 8
Plug in the Intelligent Key



Step 9
Turn the programme selector switch to position 1 "Transport mode"



Step 10
Lower the squeegee with the central yellow handle



Step 11
Press the pedal for lowering the cleaning head downwards slightly and then move it to the left



Step 12
Select the driving speed at the rotary knob



Step 13
To drive forward, press the driving lever to the front. To stop the machine, release the driving lever



Step 14
To drive reverse, press the driving lever to the rear. To stop the machine, release the driving lever



Step 15
To stop, release the driving lever



Step 16
Adjust the water quantity using the regulating button; increase the water if the floor is dirtier



Step 17
For daily cleaning, turn the programme selector switch to Eco mode. You can select other modes if the floor requires



Step 18
Floor scrubbing is finished. Turn off the water



Step 19
Release driving lever



Step 20
Set the program selection switch to suction or vacuum



Step 21
Briefly drive forward to suck up the remaining water

Step 22
Turn the program selection switch to "OFF"



Step 23
Take the water discharge hose from the support and lower above a suitable collection device



Step 24
Rinse the wastewater tanks with the rinsing system



Step 25
Leave the cover open to allow it to dry



Step 26
Loosen the lid to empty the fresh water - do not remove it fully. Drain water



Step 27
Lift off the yellow debris tray. Empty debris, rinse tray and replace tray back in the machine



Step 28
Detach hose. Kneel with kneeling pad, unscrew the two star screws and remove squeegee



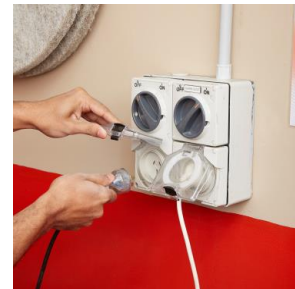
Step 29
Clean squeegee by wiping the blade. Check the condition of the blade and hang overnight in the Coles Services Department



Step 30
Wipe skirt clean with a damp cloth



Step 31
Remove the Intelligent Key



Step 32
Insert the plug of the connecting cable into the socket



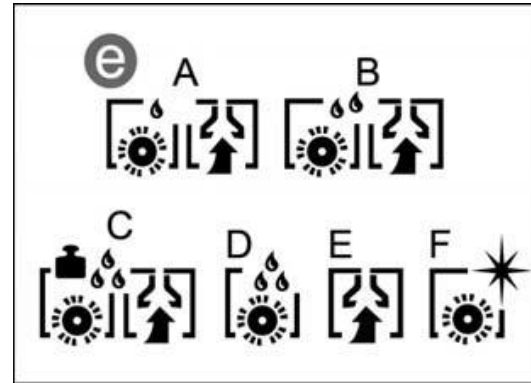
Step 33
Wash filters and pads and hang to dry in the Coles Services Department

- **REMEMBER** Release the driving lever to stop the machine
- Ensure the settings are correct to minimise water left on the floor by the scrubber
- Use your scourer and scraper to remove difficult marks and stickers
- When scrubbing, always start on either the right or left hand side of an aisle, never the middle



- a) **Eco mode**
Wet clean the floor and vacuum up dirty water
- b) **Normal mode**
Wet clean the floor and vacuum up dirty water
- c) **Increased brush contact pressure**
Wet clean the floor (with increased brush contact pressure) and vacuum up dirty water
- d) **Intense mode**
Wet clean the floor and allow the detergent to react
- e) **Vacuum mode**
Vacuum the wastewater
- f) **Polishing mode**
Polish the floor without the application of liquid
