- ✓ Pioneer Eclipse Rebound (refer to floor schedule)
- ✓ Pioneer Eclipse Neutral Cleaner (refer to floor schedule)
- ✓ Lobby pan set
- ✓ Dust control broom/fringe mop

! WARNING! – DO NOT use the machine if it is not operating correctly or damaged. Report it immediately to your Manager on duty, then let your Line Manager know.



Step 1
Put on disposable gloves and erect safety sign in place



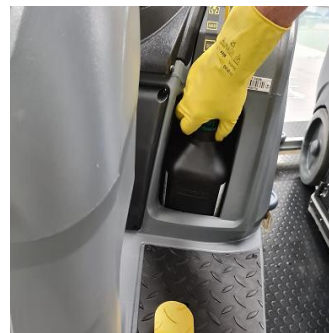
Step 2
Turn off the power, unplug the charger from the mains holding the plug. Wind the mains cable around the holders



Step 3
Open the tank lid, use the hose and open the water supply (max. 60c, max. 5 bars)



Step 4 (manual only)
Wearing safety goggles, pour the correct chemical into the fresh water tank. Refer to Daily Floor Care chart for appropriate chemical



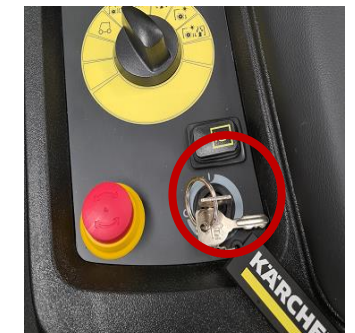
Step 4 (auto dose only)
Check auto dose bottle to ensure the correct chemical has been inserted and there is enough chemical to complete the task



Step 5
Attach pad to pad driver by inserting pad under the central locating point



Step 6
Attach pad driver to scrubber machine by pushing up into place



Step 7
Insert the key and turn on

Step 8
Turn the programme selector switch to position 1 "Transport mode"



Step 9
Release the parking brake



Step 10
Pull the lever up to raise/lower the vacuum bar, press toward the outside and lower



Step 11
Press down the rear surface of the pedal to raise/lower the cleaning head, release and let the pedal move upwards



Step 12
Set the drive direction using the drive direction button on the operator console



Step 13
Determine the driving speed by pressing the pedal



Step 14
To stop, release the drive pedal



Step 15
Adjust the water quantity using the regulating button; increase the water if the floor is dirtier



Step 16
For daily cleaning, turn the selection switch to scrubbing mode. You can select other modes if the floor requires it



Step 17
Floor scrubbing is finished. Turn off the water



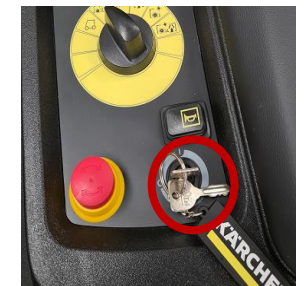
Step 18
Release driving lever



Step 19
Set the program selection switch to suction or vacuum



Step 20
Briefly drive forward to suck up the remaining water



Step 21
Turn scrubber off with the key

Step 22
Take the water discharge hose from the support and lower above a suitable collection device



Step 23
Rinse the waste water tank



Step 24
Leave the cover open to allow it to dry



Step 25
Unscrew the filter cup of the fresh water tank and let the fresh water tank drain completely. Replace the filter cup



Step 26
Detach hose. Kneel with kneeling pad, unscrew the two star screws and remove squeegee



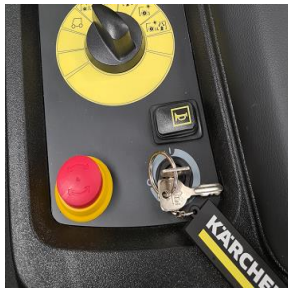
Step 28
Clean squeegee by wiping the blade. Check the condition of the blade and hang overnight in the Coles Services Department



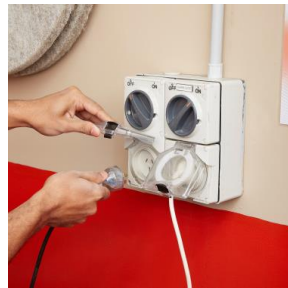
Step 29
Wipe skirt clean with a damp cloth.



Step 30
Wash filters and pads and hang to dry in the Coles Services Department



Step 31
Remove the key



Step 32
Insert the plug of the connecting cable into the socket



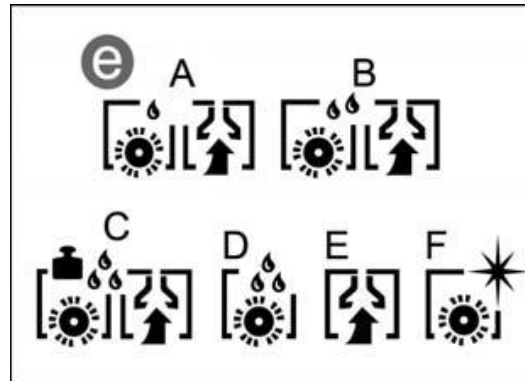
Step 33
Return safety sign and the scrubber machine to the correct position in the Coles Services Department

- **REMEMBER** Release the driving lever to stop the machine
- Ensure the settings are correct to minimise water left on the floor by the scrubber
- Use your scourer and scraper to remove difficult marks and stickers
- When scrubbing always start on either the right or left hand side of an aisle, never the middle



- a) **Eco mode**
Wet clean the floor and vacuum up dirty water
- b) **Normal mode**
Wet clean the floor and vacuum up dirty water
- c) **Increased brush contact pressure**
Wet clean the floor (with increased brush contact pressure) and vacuum up dirty water
- d) **Intense mode**
Wet clean the floor and allow the detergent to react
- e) **Vacuum mode**
Vacuum the wastewater
- f) **Polishing mode**
Polish the floor without the application of liquid
